Tammy stated that we had several individual move-downs as well as two team move-downs (LJCC 4.5 to 4.0 and Lifetime Standifer 5.3/5.5 to 5.0) She also made us aware of move-ups as well as players required to play 1st court. These are sent to all Level Coordinators and should be shared with any and all teams affected.

Tracy Smith then announced our Fall Winners and Runners up. These are listed on the website. The prizes for the winners a \$25. gift card for the Greystone CC Tennis Pro Shop and the runners up will receive a \$20. gift card.

Lavonda then reported all New Business and stated that we do not have a date set for the Susan Briggs Tournament yet but that will be forthcoming. We have 2 new Level Coordinators-Heather Morgan for 3.5 and Meredith Vinson for 4.0. She also stated that we are always in need of new Club Reps and Coordinators and if anyone knows of someone that would be interested in getting involved to please reach out to her for more information. We will be getting a Website refresh this summer to hopefully make our site more user friendly as well as more accessible from your phone. She asked for Club Reps to make sure their Club Rosters are updated and current and to make sure we are removing players or marking them inactive on the website. She further stated that anytime a player is moved from one club to another all involved individuals should be notified by email of the change. This included Captains, Level Coordinators, Club Reps and the player. Lavonda also reported that there is some discussion of maybe starting a Summer League with a different format as well as talk of starting a PickleBall League and she would keep us posted on those developments. We were also made aware of court reconstruction going on at Wald Park and that should be finished by Fall. Lavonda then asked if anyone had anything else to discuss and then adjourned the meeting after asking Tracy Smith to give out door prizes.
