Due to the overwhelming response and generosity of our players, the tournament committee has been able to award numerous scholarship awards to individuals and organizations over the years.

Participating players come from the metro Birmingham area, as well as Jasper, Gasden, Anniston, Pell City, and Tuscaloosa.

The tournament is a doubles only format which will rely on a combined rating system and provide leveled play at : 2.5, 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5, and 5.0. The committee will verify ratings and place teams in the most competitive levels according to both player's ratings.

Be aware that we have no control over forfeits, which means you may have a BYE the first round. However, we work very hard to guarantee each team two matches during the tournament.

Match play will begin on Monday, August 18th. Primary play will be Monday and Tuesday. Wednesday will be the finals. Thursday and Friday are rainout options. Matches could start as early as 9:00 am. Depending on the heat we will have either one or two matches per day. USTA rules of play will be observed.
